3. Cultivate a culture in which brave work, tough conversation, and whole hearts are the expectations, and armor is not necessary or rewarded.



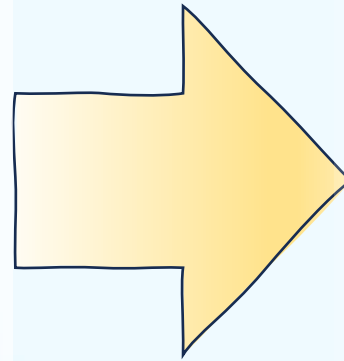
